POLICY STATEMENT 7  
Subject: Dennis D. Norbury Award  
Last Reviewed: August 2014

### **POLICY**

This award will be dispersed annually to a practicing CRNM member who is a part-time or full-time student enrolled in a BPRN, Certificate program or Graduate studies. The amount of the award granted will be determined by the interest generated Dennis D. Norbury fund held in trust by the Winnipeg Foundation.

The program or specialty in which the applicant is studying must be obstetrics or palliative care.

### **APPLICATION OF POLICY**

1. There is no separate application form for this award.
2. The Committee will review all BPRN, Certificate and Graduate applications for eligibility of this award. If none of the applicants meet the requirements, the award will not be dispersed that year.
3. This award may be awarded in conjunction with another FRNM award.
4. FRNM in conjunction with Volunteer Home Support, will disperse the award within three months of the deadline date.
5. This award is open to graduate students from the University of Manitoba. ***U of M students applying for this award must follow the Graduate Awards policy submission guidelines.***
6. There is no application fee for this award.

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

1. Resident of Manitoba, CRNM member.
2. Academic achievements, including publications related to obstetrics or palliative care.
3. Work history in obstetrics or palliative care.
4. Community service and volunteer work in obstetrics or palliative care.
5. Involvement in professional/interest groups related to obstetrics or palliative care.
6. Future career and academic goals related to obstetrics or palliative care.
7. References

### **RECIPIENTS' OBLIGATIONS**

1. Advise the Foundation of any change of address while enrolled in the program.
2. Submit to the Foundation proof of successful completion of the program.
3. Return the total amount immediately or as arranged by the FRNM should the academic term for which funding is given is not completed by the specified date.
