POLICY STATEMENT 8

Subject: Manitoba Gerontological Nursing Association (MGNA) Award

Last Reviewed: August, 2014

POLICY

Up to two awards will be awarded annually to practicing CRNM members enrolled in a certificate, BPRN or graduate program who meet the following requirements. The amount of the award will be determined by the interest generated by the MGNA fund held in trust by the Winnipeg Foundation.

1. The applicant must be a member of the Manitoba Gerontological Nursing Association (MGNA) at the time of submission of application. A photocopy of current MGNA membership card must be included with the application.
2. The area of study of the applicant must be in the field of gerontological nursing.
3. Full-time or part-time students are eligible to apply.
4. This award is open to University of Manitoba graduate students.
5. Deadline for submission is May 1st commencing May 2013.

APPLICATION OF POLICY

1. This award may be awarded in conjunction with another FRNM award.
2. General applicants must include in their cover letter how they meet selection criteria outlined below.
3. ***University of Manitoba graduate students applying for this award must follow the Graduate Award policy and include information in the cover letter outlining how they meet the selection criteria.***
4. A photocopy of current MGNA membership is required with application.
5. There is no application fee for this award.

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Resident of Manitoba
2. Academic achievements, including publications related to gerontological nursing.
3. Work history in gerontological nursing.
4. Community service and volunteer work in gerontological areas.
5. Involvement in professional/interest groups related to gerontological nursing.
6. Future career and academic goals related to gerontological nursing.
7. Qualities as outlined in reference form.

RECIPIENTS' OBLIGATIONS

1. Advise FRNM of any change of address while enrolled in the program.
2. Return the total amount of the award immediately or as arranged by FRNM should the program not be completed by the specified date.
